3.4% of households did not have a Telephone

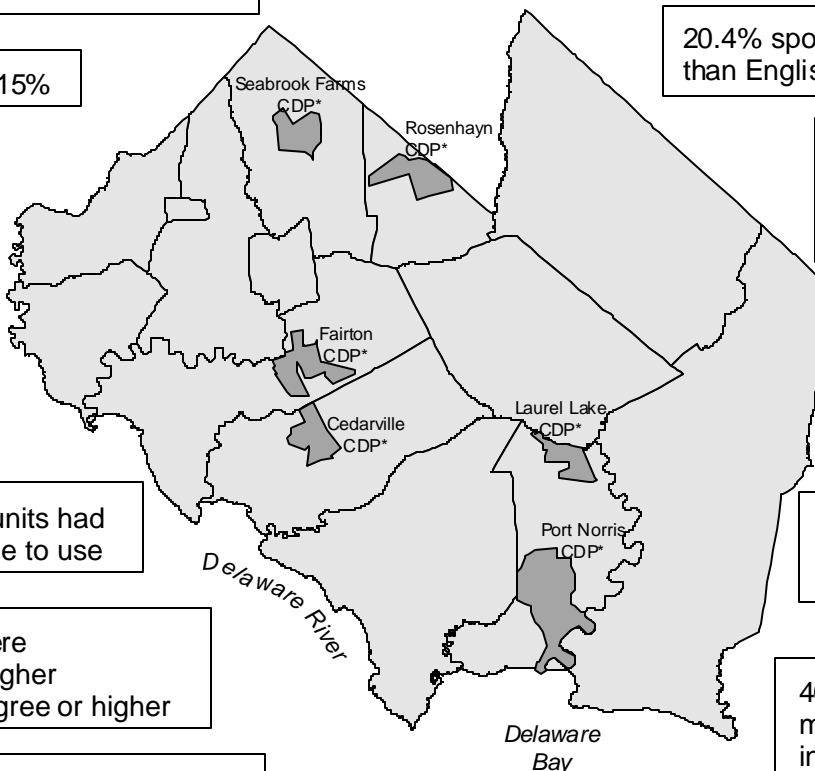
58% of those aged 16 or over were in the labor force.

Median monthly housing cost for homeowners with a mortgage was \$1,044; for the State \$1,534.
Owners without mortgages \$408; for the state \$533

30% of households had Social Security income; mean income was \$11,270.
5.3% received public assistance; mean \$2,721.
