**PERSONAL ASSISTANCE
SERVICES PROGRAM**

The Personal Assistance Services Program makes it possible for adults with physical disabilities to work, attend school or vocational training and to live independently in the community. Personal Assistants help individuals with tasks such as light housekeeping, bathing, dressing, shopping, meal preparation, correspondence, mobility, driving and / or use of public transportation.

You may be eligible for PASP if you are:

- ◆ a New Jersey resident
- ◆ physically disabled
- ◆ between the ages of 18 and 65
- ◆ living in the community (private home, apartment, boarding or group home)
- ◆ capable of directing and supervising your own services

Services are available to individuals who are or wish to be employed, preparing for employment, attending an educational or training program, or to support active participation in community based activities such as volunteer service or parenting.
