Re: Cooperative Contract for Deer Carcass Removal Services

On September 15, 2010, the County of Cumberland, solicited bids for Providing Deer Carcass Removal Services for itself and for the Cumberland County Cooperative Contract Purchasing System, Identifier Number 181-CCCCPS, as authorized by N.J.S.A. 40 A:11-11(6) and regulated by N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.1.

This legislation permits government entities within the geographic boundaries of Cumberland County to utilize any contract made by the County provided that the successful bidder to the County is awarded a contract and has elected to extend their prices, and the terms and conditions of the County contract, to those government entities.

On October 28, 2010, the Cumberland County Board of Chosen Freeholders adopted a resolution (copy attached) to award an open-ended contract to Deer Carcass Removal Services, LLC, PO Box 328, Cream Ridge, New Jersey, 08514, to provide those services.

Additionally, Deer Carcass Removal Services elected to extend their prices to government entities within the geographic boundaries of the County; the Board declared them winning bidder for those government entities.

You may therefore, on a strictly voluntary basis, enter into a contract with Deer Carcass Removal Services, LLC, for the provision of those services.

All terms and conditions of the contract awarded by the County would apply to any contract made with this firm.

The total, all-inclusive removal fee is \$55.00 per carcass.

The contract starts November 1, 2010, and terminates October 31, 2011.

The contractor shall be on-call seven (7) days per week.

The contractor is required to remove all carcasses by 5:00 PM on the calendar day following the removal request.
