

**Application for Cumberland County Military Service Medal**

The Board of Chosen Freeholders has commissioned a Cumberland County Military Service Medal to recognize local Veterans' who honorably served their country and their county.

Under the guidance of the Cumberland County Veterans' Commission a design has been selected incorporating the official County flag. It depicts the County Liberty Bell surrounded by 14 stars representing each of the County's municipalities. It also includes the inscribed date of 1748, which is the year Cumberland County was founded.

Appropriate ceremonies are being arranged for medal presentations. Veterans' who qualify for the medal will be notified of the date, location and time of the ceremony.
