

Cumberland County's COVID-19 Drive-Thru Clinic

Guidance for Clinicians

The Cumberland County Health Department (“CCDOH”), in partnership with the Vineland Health Department and CompleteCare Health Network (“CCHN”), will be hosting a COVID-19 testing (specimen collection) site at the Rowan College of South Jersey campus, beginning on Thursday, April 2, 2020.

Testing resources are limited. Only residents who meet the eligibility criteria below will be tested. Physicians should use their best clinical judgement to determine if a test is necessary. Remember, individuals who are not at high risk for adverse outcomes will not see a clinical benefit to testing, as their treatment will be the same, regardless of the test result.

Who is **NOT ELIGIBLE** for testing at drive-thru:

- The “worried well” and/or asymptomatic patients without a physician’s order or “script”
- Ill patients who do not have a physician’s script
- Those who reside outside of Cumberland County

Who **IS ELIGIBLE** for testing at drive-thru:

- Complete Care Inc. symptomatic patients
- Cumberland County residents (valid photo ID required) who are:
 - Symptomatic
 - Present a physician’s script for SARS-CoV-2 testing

Symptomatic patients must meet the following criteria:

- Patients with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 such as:
 - Fever
 - cough
 - shortness of breath
 - other associated symptoms of respiratory illness
 - and should be prioritized if:
 - patient is a direct contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case
 - has traveled to an area with a CDC level 3 travel advisory
 - age >65
 - other serious underlying medical conditions
 - healthcare workers or first responders

No clinic dates/times will be made public. The following describes the process for your eligible patients to get their scheduled date and time at the drive-thru clinic:

1. Physicians with patients that meet testing criteria can have their patients register through CCHN at CompleteCareNJ.org or call 856-451-4700 to be tested.
2. Once CCHN screens the patient and approves for testing, they will process a lab requisition through LabCorp.
3. CCHN will then provide lab requisition slips to Cumberland County Health Department via fax or secure web based system.
4. Patients will be contacted by Cumberland County Health Department to be given location, date, and time of their appointment at drive-thru clinic.
5. No co-pays or out of pocket expenses will occur for screening or testing.
6. **Every effort will be made to screen patients accordingly and ensure only those that fit the testing criteria receive appointments. If physicians have concerns regarding a patient, please reach out to CompleteCare or the Health Department that serves the jurisdiction in which the patient lives.**
