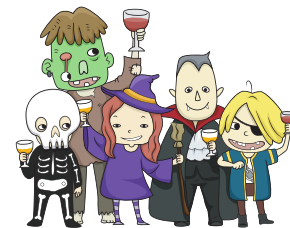
- TRICK OR TREATING IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD, TRUNK OR TREAT EVENTS AT YOUR SCHOOL

- GOING ON HAYRIDES OR TRACTOR RIDES, ATTENDING INDOOR EVENTS, VISITING INDOOR HALLOWEEN ATTRACTIONS WITH LARGE GROUPS OF PEOPLE WHO ARE NOT IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD
