

Attention: Realtors, landlords, & new home buyers,

The New Jersey Private Well Testing Act Rule was amended September 4, 2018 to include additional parameters for required testing. The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has expanded the required parameters for Southern counties to include Arsenic. Please ensure that you are analyzing and reporting for Arsenic as this parameter is required for your customers to obtain a water certification from our office.



Additionally, starting March 3, 2019 the synthetic organic compounds, 1,2,3-trichloropropane (1,2,3-TCP), ethylene dibromide (EBD), and 1,2-dibromo-3-chloropropane will become requirements of PWTA. Analyzing and reporting for these parameters will be necessary to obtain a water certification from this Department at that time.
